Welcome to the Parish of Burchetts Green.

Anyone who lives within the boundaries of our parish seeking a Christian marriage is entitled to be married in one of our churches. We have three church buildings within our parish

- St Mary the Virgin, in Hurley
- St John the Evangelist, in Littlewick Green
- St James the Less, in Stubbings

Whichever church is chosen, couples need to contact the parish office.

Exceptionally it is possible to be married by licence. If you are not sure if you qualify please contact the parish office.

The next step is to arrange a meeting, these are usually on Saturday mornings and an appointment needs to be made by phoning the Parish Office (01628 820077)

The church believes it is very important that those who want to get married take time to consider deeply the steps being taken in committing each other to a life-long relationship. Preparation courses are arranged within the parish and provide an opportunity for couples to share together ideas about ways in which relationships develop; and think about religious beliefs and the marriage service itself.

GETTING MARRIED

Marriage by Banns

Please be sure that you attend church at least once (in both churches) to hear your banns read. Also be sure to collect your certificate from the other church, whoever is officiating will need to see this certificate before your marriage and WILL NOT marry you without seeing it.

Marriage by Special Licence

You need to apply to The Registrar of the Court of Faculties, 1 The Sanctuary, London SW1P 3JT (020 7222 5381). If you are to be married by licence you will be required to pay a fee direct to the Archbishop's Office, the total cost for a licence is in the region of £133.

Flowers

Even if you are using a florist please contact our flower organisers. They need to know if you are leaving any flowers in church after your service. They may be able to organise flowers for you and they will also be able to advise you about the church building.
